 granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain
 sell and release unto the said Peter French all that plantation or tract of lands
 containing one hundred acres (be the same more or less) Situate in the district
 aforesaid, lying on Saluda river and mountain creek, Beginning on a Sapipap
 24. running thence N. 12. W. 9 chains to a poplar st. thence S. 82. W. 1. 10. to a white oak st.
 thence N. 8. E. 12. 25. to a stake st. the above mentioned line are bounded by the said
 Peter Frenchs land, thence N. 68. E. 9. 75. to a white oak st. thence N. 35. E. 14. ch. to a
 dogwood st. near mountain creek thence down the meanders of said creek 40
 from high water mark to a hickory st. thence S. 25. W. 25 chains to a pine st. thence N.
 65. W. to Saluda river thence up the meanders of said river to the Beginning
