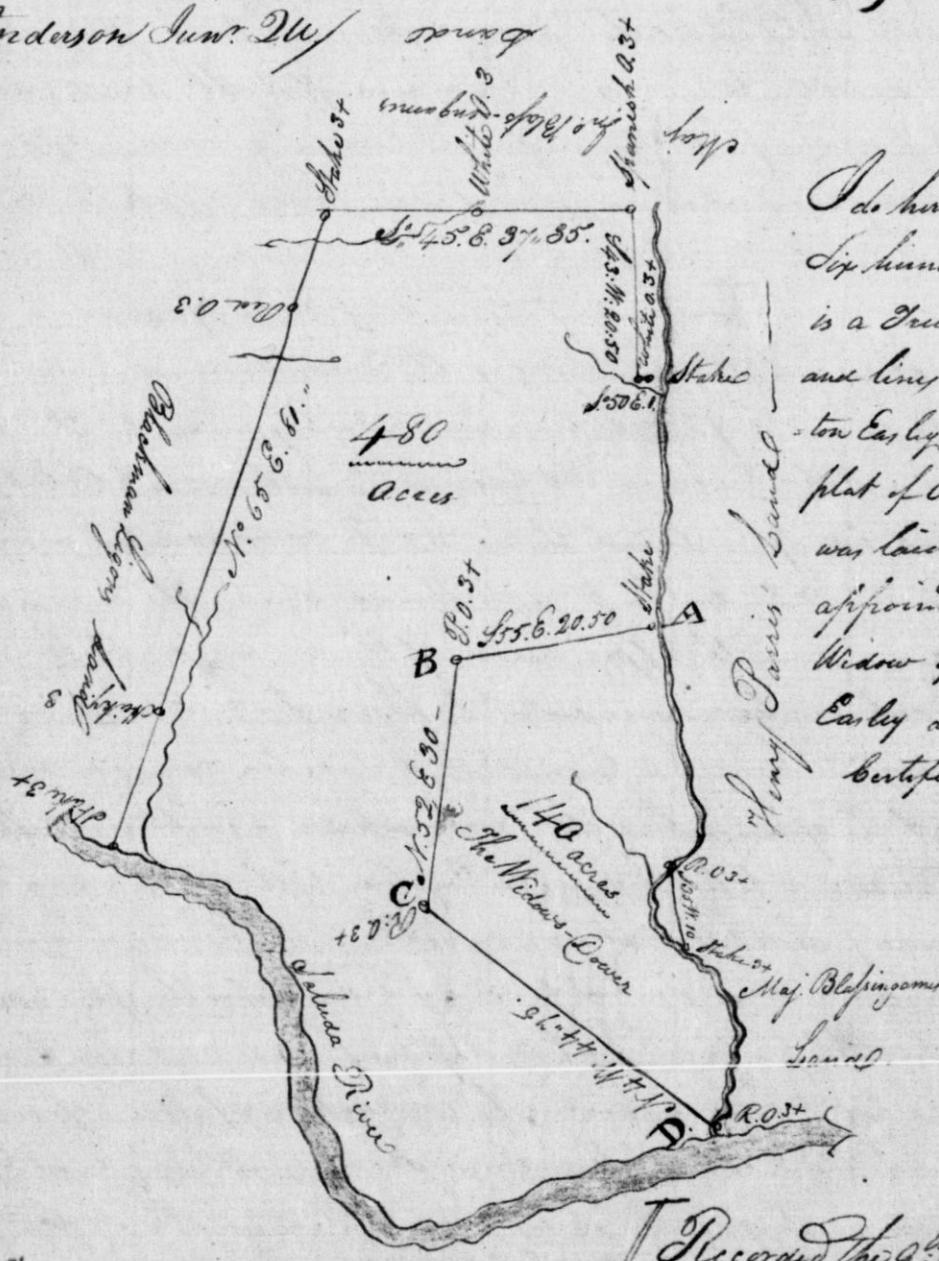

State South Carolina Greenville Dist. I know all men by these presents that I Benjamin Pollard Senr. of State & Dist. aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me in hand paid by H. Griffin of the State and District aforesaid, Have granted bargained and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release to the said H. Griffin two hundred acres of land more or less, together with two thirds of a mill that is situated on the said tract of land, the said land being situated on the water of Piles branch, Beginning on a poplar stump on W. Coxs line thence running up Piles branch to the middle of the water crossing the mill dam to a corner on a maple stump in the pond thence westwardly one chain to a lightwood stake thence northward two chain to a Oak corner on Jany Samford line thence running westward along the de Indian path.
