

shall, well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said party of the second part his attorney or heirs, executor, administrators or assigns, the sum of four hundred dollars, which the second party is bound in a bond to the Sheriff of Greenville District, South Carolina, for the said Jeremiah Strother, appearance to Greenville Courthouse the nineteenth day of March next also the fourth of April, and twelfth October there to defend a suit brought against him by James Dinsley, but in case default shall be made in payment of all or any part of the said Principle sum of four hundred dollars on the interest Cost of suit thereof, it shall and may be lawfull for the said Party of the second part at any after the twelfth day of October next - or if the said Strother fails to appear and give himself up to the Sheriff of the State and District aforesaid, the nineteenth day of March next to sell and dispose of the said Negroes hereby granted at Public Vendue to any person or persons whomsoever, and on such sale to make sign Seal and deliver any Bill of Sale that the law requires and out of the money arising from such sale or sales to keep and retain in their hands the said sum of four hundred dollars the interest costs of suit and all officers fees as shall then be due together with all costs of such sale or sales and the over plus money if any shall be paid to the said party of the first part or his heirs: In Witness whereof to these presents have hereunto set their hands & seals this day & date above written -
