Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred dollars cash in hand paid by the said Fielding Wigginton to William Wigginton the s. W. Wigginton hath bargained sold and delivered unto the said Fielding Wigginton on half of a certain tract of land containing five acres more or less situate on the north side of Enore river including all the buildings on said land with all the other improvements occupied by the s. William Wigginton excepted half the shop and privilage thereof, all and singular the rights members hereditaments and ~~appurtenances~~ Privilage, unto the only proper use and behoof of him the said Fielding Wigginton during his natural life or pleasure to occupy possess and enjoy the above mentioned Parcel of land it being part of a Lot of land leased to Wigginton by Henry Benson & Joshua Benson and I the s. William Wigginton do warrant and defend said parcel of land from all lawfull claims during the natural life of s. Fielding Wigginton.
