 all and singular the rights, members and appurtenances thereto belonging
 or in any wise appertaining, and the reversion & reversion, remainder & remainders
 rents issues and profits thereof, To have & To hold the said tract of land & premises,
 with the appurtenance unto the said William Mathers Junr. his heirs and
 assigns forever Provided always nevertheless and it is the true intent and
 meaning of the parties to these presents that if the said John Blankinship
 his heirs, executors or administrators shall well and truly pay or cause to be
 paid unto the said William Mathers Junr. the said sum of four hundred
 and ten dollars and fifty cents according to the note above mentioned then &
 from thenceforth these presents shall be utterly null & void, any thing herein
 contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding, and it is covenanted
 and agreed upon by & between the parties to these presents, that untill default
 shall be made in payment of the aforesaid sum as before set forth
 and the interest for the same it shall & may be lawfull to and for the said
 John Blankinship peaceably & quietly to hold, use occupy possess and enjoy
 all and singular the premises above granted and released, and every part thereof
 with the appurtenances, and to have receive and take the rents, issues and profits
 thereof to his own particular use and behoof, any thing herein contained
 to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding, In Witness whereof
