To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Lewis Pike his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Lewis Pike his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand and seal this twenty ninth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & eight - and in the thirty first year of the independency of the United States of America
