 and my heirs and against every person whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to
 claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand and seal this twenty
 ninth day of February in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred &
 Eight - and in the thirty first year of the independancy of the united States of America
