 Slaves, To wit a negro boy Jacob - a boy called Philip - a negro Wench Lydia, and her
 child, a negro woman Sylvia, and a negro fellow named Ransom —
 To Have and To Hold the said negro Slaves together with the increase of the female
 unto the said William Walton & Company their executors administrators and assigns
 forever, provided always nevertheless, that if the said John Archer his heirs executors or
 administrators shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said
 William Walton and John Walton or either of them, their certain attorney executors
 administrators or assigns the full and just sum of Two thousand four hundred
 and twenty three dollars thirty five cents with interest thereon, according to the
 true intent and meaning of the bond and condition aforesaid, and of these presents,
 together with lawfull interest which shall become due thereon then this deed of
 bargain and sale and all and every clause article and thing therein contained
 shall cease, determine and be utterly void and of none effect, any thing herein before
 contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding, And it is hereby declared
 by and between the said parties, and the said John Archer for himself his executors
 administrators and assigns both covenant promise and agree to and with the said
 William Walton and John Walton otherwise called William Walton and Company
 their executors administrators and assigns by these presents, that if default
 shall happen to be made, of, or in payment of the said sum of Two thousand
 four hundred and twenty three dollars 35 cents with the interest thereon —
 as aforesaid, according to the true intent and meaning of the said condition
 that then and in such case it shall and may be lawful to and for the said William
 Walton & John Walton them or either of them their or either of their Executors
 administrators, assigns, attorneys or agents from time to time and at all times
 hereafter peaceably and quietly to enter into any or all the messuages lands, or
 Tenements of the said John Archer and to take the said Slaves into their custody &
 possession and the same to hold and detain to their own use and behoof (within
 their proper goods & chattles) from thence forth and forever, or the same to sell &
 dispose of, at their will and pleasure returning the overplus if any should happen
 to be after paying the said sum of Two thousand four hundred and twenty three
 dollars thirty five cents with the interest as aforesaid, ^{unto the said John Archer his} executors administrators or assigns
 In Witness whereof I the said John Archer have hereunto set my hand and seal
 this seventeenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight
 Hundred and Eight, and of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States
 of America the thirty second, sealed and delivered in the presence
