S 18. W 2. 50 to P. O. st. then S 75. E 30. to H. B. st. S 80. E 19. 50 to the Beginning which includes
the land to be conveyed. Together with all and singular the Right Members, Hereditaments
thereunto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. And I do hereby bind myself ~~my~~ my
heir &c^m &c^m to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises above mentioned
unto the said Benjamin Smith his heirs &c^m &c^m and assigns forever —
