Beginning on a Stake Run N 68. 46. 40. to stake on Lesters line then S 70. 11. 3 to Stake then S 15 W 23. 50 to Post 34 on then N. 2. 57 to post 34 then S 34. 22 to Post oak 34 then N. 69. E by dividing line between Wadsworths and himself to the beginning, including two hundred acres Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances unto the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To Have & To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Samuel Crawford, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Exors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the
