The State of South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that Hugh M'Kay of the District Greenville & State aforesaid in consideration of four hundred dollars to him in hand paid by David Brock of Greenville District and State aforesaid, Have granted and bargained, sold and delivered and by these presents Do grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said Brock a tract of land containing two hundred and twenty acres more or less being & lying in Greenville district on both sides of Sandy branch a branch of Reedy River a part of a tract of land surveyed of 489 acres granted to Jeremiah Lauston by his Excellency W^m Moultrie Esq bearing date the 27th day of November 1785. and recorded in Secretaries office grant book K K K K page 119. Beginning at a Chestnut tree running thence to a post & thence to a hickory on John Cuncan thence along s^d land to a hickory on David Brock line thence along said line to a hickory John Montgomery thence along said line to a post oak on Alexander Montgomery thence along said line to the Beginning containing two hundred and twenty acres of land more or less, Together with all & singular the rights and titles appurtenant to said land belonging or in any wise - and to hold and singular the premises before mentioned unto the s^d David Brock his heirs forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Brock his heirs against myself & assigns and every other person or persons -
