Know all men by these presents that I John Peace Have bargained and sold
 and by these presents Have bargained sold a certain parcel or tract of Land
 lying & being in the District of Greenville & State of South Carolina on the waters of S.
 Pacolet on the head branches of a Stream known by the name of Greens creek being
 part of a Survey granted to Samuel McFlora and then conveyed to the said John
 Peace, and now the N.W. end of the survey unto the said Joseph King. Beginning
 at the branch that comes out of the mountain on the N. West side of said tract
 and down the said Spring branch to where it intersects with the Spring branch to a
 large poplar that stands in the fork of the two said Spring branches and up the same course
 to where it will meet the original line on a stake, & then west to the original Stake, from
 thence on the original line, adjoining abner Senter's Station trees Chestnut & other to it
 come to the corner on the hill side and thence as the original line goeth east to the said
 branch where this said conveyance begins, by estimation twenty five acres more or
 less. With all its appurtenance profits and advantages free and clear of all incumbrance
 unto the said Joseph King his heirs and assigns forever. To Have and To Hold from the said
 John Peace doth on his part him his heirs and every of them warrant and defend
 the same unto said. from every person claiming or to claim any part thereof lawfully
 Whereunto I have set my hand and affixed my seal this first day of October in
 the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Eight. Signed Sealed
