This Indenture made this twentieth day of July one thousand eight hundred and nine, between Joseph King of State of South Carolina and Greenville District, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Michael Pruett of the State and District aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold released and delivered and by these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto the s^d Michael Pruett his heirs & assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of land in the State and District aforesaid, & on the waters of the said River Tyger called Morgans Creek, Beginning on mountain bench on a big Molle branch on bank of a branch called Noche branch thence down said branch to the mouth, and thence up a branch that comes in on the other side till it strikes Sinters old line thence N 63 E to white oak thence N 10 chains to a chestnut thence W 16 chains to a white oak thence N to the Beginning corner, it being fifty acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members & premises above mentioned to the said Michael Pruett his heirs and assigns forever, and s^d King doth by these presents warrant and forever defend the said tract of Land to the said Michael Pruett his heirs and assigns forever, against myself my heirs and assigns, and against all other Persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof - In witness whereof the s^d King hath hereunto his hand and affixed his seal this day and year first above written signed sealed and delivered in the Presence of us -
