Know all men by these presents that I John Mottow of the State and district aforesaid in consideration of one hundred and fifty dollars to me paid by John Gaultenry of the place aforesaid Have granted bargain sold and released to the s^d John Gaultenry all that parcel or tract of land, containing by estimation two hundred and nineteen acres being part of a tract of land originally granted to Austin Clayton the first July 1793. conveyed from William Stanford to Pleasant Casley and from him to Daniel Wilbanks and from him to Joseph S. Mottow and so to me as administrator of Joseph S. Mottow, Situate in the district aforesaid on Fortenberry beaverdam creek on both sides of the wild cat branch, Beginning one lightwood stake on land laid out to Wm Swift. running S. 45 N. by ch^o 50 Lk^s to a chestnut 34 thence S. 58. E. 10 ch^o to a black oak 34 thence N. 21. E. 18. ch^o to a Persimmon 34 thence down the several meanders of the wild cat branch to a dogwood 34 thence S. 60. E. 19 ch^o to a black oak 34 thence N. 46. E. 43 ch^o to the Beginning Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have & To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Gaultenry his heirs and assigns forever, (and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend against myself and my heirs and against every other Person whomsoever Lawfully Claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand and day of June anno Domini 1809. and in the 33rd of American Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence of John Kelly.
