and forever defend all and singular the above described Premises unto the  
said Blagrove Gleason his heirs & exec<sup>r</sup>s adms<sup>r</sup> and assigns forever against myself  
my heirs exec<sup>r</sup>s adms<sup>r</sup> and against every other person or persons whomsoever  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand  
and seal this 15<sup>th</sup> day of March 1810 and in the thirty fourth and thirty fifth  
year of the Independence of the United States of America.
