 branch to Needy River thence down the meanders of the said River to John  
 Bakers line and thence along said Bakers line, to a Dogwood corner on  
 the side the two above pieces of Land containing in the whole five hundred  
 acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members heredita-  
 ments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident  
 or appertaining. To Have and To Hold all and singular the said premises unto  
 the said Thomas Harrison his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself  
 my heirs Executor & administrator to warrant & forever defend all and singular the  
 said premises unto the said Thomas Harrison his heirs and assigns against myself and  
 my heirs and against every person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim  
 the same or any part thereof - In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
 and seal, this fiftth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight  
 hundred and ten, and in the thirty fourth year of American Independance
