sell and release unto the said Carter Tarrant all that tract or parcel of Land
situate lying being in the district of Greenville and state aforesaid on the grove creek
and bounded as follows: To wit, Beginning at a live oak stamp running N. 81° E.
white oak thence S. W. 7:42 to a crab apple tree \$45 6.59 75 to a post oak stamp
N. 48. E. 136 44 12. to a pine N. 27. East 32. 50 to the Beginning corner containing three
Hundred and twelve acres; Together with all and singular the Rights, members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise
incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises
before mentioned unto the said Carter Tarrant his heirs and assigns forever and
I do hereby bind myself, my heirs executors & administrators to warrant and
forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Carter Tarrant
his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof -

Thousand Eight hundred and ten, and in the thirty fourth year of the independence
