 Junr. of the County of Greenville in the State of aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of fifty
 dollars to me paid by Thomas Long Senr. of the County and State aforesaid Have
 granted bargained and Released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 and Release unto the said Thomas Long Senr. Ten acres of Land more or less lying
 on the North side of Reedy River in Greenville County being part of a tract of
 Land originally granted to Lewis Sewall by his excellency William Moultrie
 on the thirty first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hun-
 dred and Eighty six, as by a plat annexed to said grant will more fully appear
 the said Ten acres more or less is laid out to the said Thomas Senr. as follows,
 Beginning on a willow oak on the north bank of said Reedy River & Running Eastward
 to a pine from thence Southward to a black gum on the bank of Reedy
 River thence Running down and bounding on the said River to the Beginning
 corner, Including Ten acres more or less, Together with all singular the Rights
 members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any
 wise incident or appertaining, To Have & To Hold all and singular the Premises
 before mentioned unto the said Thomas Long Senr. his heirs and assigns, forever
 and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant, and
 forever defend all singular the said Ten acres of Land more or less with the pre-
 mises unto the said Thomas Long Senr. his heirs and assigns, against myself my
 heirs and assigns, and all and every other Person or Persons whatsoever. In
 witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and seal this 2^d day of December 1800
 in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred, Signed Sealed, and
