

State of South Carolina Greenville District. Know all men by these presents that I William O'Bryant of the district and state aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Eli Baldwin of the same district and State aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and by these presents Do grant bargain and sell unto the said Eli Baldwin two certain tracts or parcels of Land lying in Greenville district on the south side of Gilders Creek, water of Enoree River, one being a tract of one hundred and four acres that was granted to William Vaughan all but a small part was taken off by and old line which was run for John Mitcheson which begins at a red oak on Nathaniel Dacus land and land formerly the property of Joshua Perkins the said red oak being said Perkins corner, Beginning S. 15 E. 25.50 or S. Perkins line to a post oak 38 thence N. 60 E. 40 chain to a post oak 34 thence N. 15 W. to where the original line intersects with the aforesaid Mitcheson's line then on said line to a stake 34 thence continuing on said line to where it crosses the original line thence on the original line to stake 34 thence S. 10 E. 5 chain 50 link to a post oak 34 thence S. 26 W. 23 chains on Nathaniel Dacus line to the beginning red oak corner including the house and plantation whereon the said O'Bryant now lies supposed to include Eighty acres to the same more or less, the other tract supposed to include Sixty acres and hath such form and marks as may appear by a plat of the same - Together with all and singular the right members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining, To have & to hold all and singular the above Premises mentioned unto the said Eli Baldwin his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors &c to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Eli Baldwin his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs & assigns and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
