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South Carolina Greenville District; Know all men by these presents that I Alexander Jordan of said state & District for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Abraham Randell of the same state & District, hath granted bargain sold & delivered and by these presents doth grant bargain sell & deliver to the said Abraham Randell a tract or parcel of land containing two hundred acres be the same more or less situate in said district of Greenville on Fortunberis beaver dam creek of middle tyger river, it being a part of a tract of land which his excellency William Moultrie did give and grant unto Austin Clayton bearing date the first day of July 1793. and recorded in grant book G. N<sup>o</sup> 5. page 346. which tract of land containing 872 acres the aforesaid tract or parcel of land being conveyed to Robin Sutton, and Sutton to Poppon & said Alex<sup>r</sup> Jordan then Poppon his part to said Jordan containing two hundred acres more or less Beginning at a spanish oak thence N. 45 W. 16 ch. 50 lks to a red oak thence N. 10 to a pine thence N. 33 W. 53 to a stake on Barnes branch thence down said branch it meanders to Crauford's line thence with Crauford's line to Price's line thence with Price's line to a maple corner conditionally made to Sutton & Price thence to the Beginning) - Together with all and singular the Rights, premises & appurtenances
