10 South Carolina Greenville District, Know all men by these presents that I Jonathan West of the dist. & State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by James McDaniel of the dist. and State aforesaid Have bargained granted sold and released, and by these presents Do grant bargain and sell unto the said James McDaniel all that parcel or tract of land lying & being in the district and State aforesaid on the waters of the Golden grove creek, being a part of a tract of land originally granted to Jesse Moody, Beginning as follows to wit, Beginning on a red oak corner on the W. side of the trail road, and running S. 20 Chains to a Spanish oak corner thence Running N. 70 W. 14 Chains on the trail road to a chestnut corner thence N. 20 E. to a stake corner on the trail road a conditional corner thence running along the trail Road, as it now runs to a post oak conditional corner on the original line, thence W. to the Beginning including one hundred acres more or less Also one other tract of land lying on the trail Road the W. side of the same Beginning on a P. Oak on the S. West line thence S. 6. 10 to a stake corner thence S. 15. E. 24. 10 to a P. oak corner thence N. 10 W. 10 to a Spanish O. Corner thence N. 12 E. 20. to the Beginning, including Twenty four acres more or less, it being a part of a tract that James Lockman formerly lived on, Together with all and singular the rights, members and appurtenances to the above two premises, or in any wise incident thereunto, To Have & To Hold all the above mentioned premises to the said James McDaniel his heirs and assigns forever And I do bind myself my heirs, and all other persons from ever claiming the same, Witness my hand and seal this 5th day of Novem^r. 1810.
