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South Carolina Greenville District, This is to certify to all whom it may concern where as Blagrove Glenn of the State and District aforesaid Guardian for S^r Brooks did on the Twenty-Eighth day of March one thousand Eight hundred and nine give me a mort gage of certain property namely one Negroe woman name a Susannah and her child named Mary also all his household and kitchen furniture and all my plantation utensils in consequence of my being his Guardian for S^r Brooks and where as I doth fully appear from receipt given to S^r Glenn by S^r Brooks being of full age date d^o July 15th 1811 he S^r Brooks having Rec^d all monys due to him from S^r Glenn as his Guardian and given Acquittance of all claims or demands in full in law or equity I do hereby on my part resign all my rights and claims toward my Heirs Executors Administrators or Assigns of the within instrument, & Mortgage to him the W^m Blagrove Glenn his Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns forever given under my hand and seal this tenth day of Augst 1811
