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State of South Carolina Greenville District, Know all men by these presents that I James Harrison Senr of the State and district aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars paid by James Harrison Junr the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged Have granted bargained sold and delivered, and by these presents Do grant bargain sell and deliver to the said James Harrison of the District and State aforesaid all that part of a certain tract of land originally granted to Minor Minn and signed by Geo. Grier and on the 21st January 1785. for six hundred and forty acres lying and being on the bank of Reedy River in Greenville district, Beginning on the lower original line and the middle of Reedy River (John Baker corner) thence along said line croping to Reedy fork N.W. sixty six degrees to the original corner thence N.E. 24° Eighty to the original corner thence S.E. 66° to the middle of Reedy River, thence down to the middle of said River with its meanders to the Beginning, being all of said original survey lying on the west of Reedy River containing by estimation four hundred and twenty acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, franchises, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises there unto belonging in any wise incident or appertaining. To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Harrison his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant & defend all and singular the premises before mentioned to the said James, his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs and assigns & every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this tenth day of April in the year of one thousand eight hundred and ten and of the independence of America the thirty fourth, signed sealed and delivered in the presence of Benjamin Johnson, Nathaniel Townsend 3 James Harrison S.
