by these presents Do grant bargain sell and deliver to the said James Harrison
of the District and State aforesaid all that part of a certain tract of land
originally granted to Minor Mims and signed by Geo^r Guess and on the 21st day
January 1785. for six hundred and forty acres lying and being on & in the
of Reedy River in Greenville district, Beginning on the lower original line and
the middle of Reedy River (John Bahen Corner) thence along said line crossing
Reedy fork N.W. sixty six degrees to the original corner thence N.E. 21st Eighty
to the original corner thence S.E. 66^o to the middle of Reedy River, thence down
middle of said River with its meanders to the Beginning, being all of said original
survey lying on the west of Reedy River, containing by Estimation four hundred
and twenty acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, manors
