 South Carolina Greenville District. This Indenture made this fifth day of
 December one thousand eight hundred and eleven between Samuel Looe of the County
 of Greenville and State aforesaid of the one part and Henry Stokes of the County &
 State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Samuel Looe for and
 in consideration of Three hundred Dollars to him in hand paid by the s^d Henry
 Stokes at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which
 the said Samuel Looe doth acknowledge and thereof and of and from every part
 and parcel thereof doth acquit and discharge the said Henry Stokes, his heirs &
 assigns, and for other good causes, Have bargained hold aliened enfeoffed and
 confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell & confirm unto the said
 Henry Stokes, his heirs and assigns forever, part of a certain tract of Land containing
 nine hundred and seventy acres originally granted to James Barton and signed by his
 Excellency William Moultrie on the fourth day of March 1793. Situate in the district
 aforesaid on horse pen creek waters of the Enoree River Beginning at a post oak
 corner on a part of the same tract laid off for Isaac Fowler Running S. 40 W. with
 Jacob Davis line to a stake + 3 corners of said Land thence S. 80 W. 40 chain to a point + 3
 thence N. 20 W. with Wm. Nicholson line 38 chain to a box oak + 3 thence N. 40 E. 4
 chain to a box oak corner of Isaac Reedy line thence N. 45 E. to a stake standing on the
 back line thence to beginning, supposed to contain five hundred and forty six acres
 more or less. Together with all and singular the appurtenances whatsoever to the premises
 belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto, and the Reversion & Reversion, Remain-
 der and Remainder, & every part & parcel thereof, To Have & To Hold the said
 Land & Premises above mentioned with the appurtenances unto the said Henry Stokes,
 his heirs and assigns forever, the said Samuel Looe for himself & his heirs the five
 hundred and forty six acres of Land and all and singular the premises above granted
 unto the said Henry Stokes and his heirs and assigns against all persons whatsoever.
 Shall and will forever defend. In Witness whereof the said Samuel Looe hath
