in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand  
paid by Horatio Wilson of the District and State aforesaid have granted bargained  
sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto  
the said Horatio Wilson all that plantation or tract of Land lying and  
being in the District and State aforesaid on the Waters of Tiddens Creek  
Beginning on a black Oak on the Original line cornering to Joel Shelton  
it being a Conditional corner thence along <sup>the</sup> said Conditional line to a Stake  
corner on the Original line to Joel Shelton S 10 W to James Sebom's line  
thence a long said line to a Conditional line by Horatio Griffen then with  
the Conditional line cornering to a Stake on the Old line then N 10 E. to the  
Beginning including one hundred and fifty acres more or less the said land  
to be conveyed was originally granted to Joseph Reed by his Excellency Charles  
Pinckney on the sixth of June 1794 & Conveyed from Caleb Earp to J. Isaac  
Reed together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments  
and appertaining To have and To hold all and singular the said premises  
before mentioned unto the said Horatio Wilson his heirs and assigns forever  
and do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant  
and forever defend all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto  
the said Horatio Wilson against myself and my heirs and against every  
other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any  
part thereof. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal  
this 1<sup>st</sup> day of February in the year of Our Lord 1806
