 of Greenville District in the State aforesd. for and in consideration of one hundred
 Dollars to me in hand paid by Benjamin Smith of the State and District
 aforesaid. I have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain, sell
 and Release unto the said Benjamin Smith his heirs and assigns forever, all that
 tract of Land including the plantation whereon I Harbin now live, containing
 One hundred and twelve acres be the same more or less, situate in the State and
 District aforesd. on the south side of the south fork of Rocky Creek of Enoree River
 Beginning on a sweet gum corner on the south bank of said Creek Runs S. 11 E. 34ⁿ
 50 on John Harbin's line to a post oak & thence S. 55 W. 850 to a chestnut & thence
 N. 67 W. 38:50 to a black oak & thence N. 23 W. 18:50 to a white oak & on the north side
 of said creek thence down the middle of said creek to the Beginning which includes the
 the full land to be conveyed be the same more or less. Together with all and
 singular the rights, members, hereditaments, & appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any
 wise incident or appertaining. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs & assigns
 to warrant and forever defend all and singular the above described premises
 unto the said Benjamin Smith his heirs & assigns and assigns against myself &
 my heirs & against every other Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
