of Greenville district in consideration of the sum of one hundred Dollars to me paid
by James West of the S. District I have granted Bargained and sold and
released and by these presents do grant Bargain sell and release unto the
said James West a plantation or tract of Land lying and being in
Greenville District supposed to contain one hundred acres Be the same
more or less situate on a branch of Beaverdam Creek of South Tyger river
Beginning on a black Oak on the North side of the branch thence a straight
line to a hickory thence N.W. to a black Oak at the head of a branch
thence N.E. to a black Oak Stake on John Sparkers line thence along
Sparkers line to a hickory thence along Gilbreaths line to a Maple thence
along said George Gilbreaths line to a pine Stake thence down to a spring
Branch of Robert Warters thence down the said Branch to a white Oak
thence a straight line to a maple in a small branch thence down the
said branch to the main branch that runs thro the plantation thence
up the branch to the Beginning. Together with all and singular the rights
members hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise incident
or appertaining therunto, To have & To hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said James West his heirs & assigns forever, and I do hereby bind
myself my heirs & executors & administrators to warrant and for ever defend all singular
the s^d premises unto the said James West his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs
and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this 18th day of December in the
year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and seven, and in the thirty second
year of American Independence Signed Sealed & Delivered in the presence of us the
Witnesses, Jas. George Gilbreath Sol. Bruce } James G. Gray
Greenville District; This day came George Gilbreath one of the witnesses to the within conveyance before
me and made oath that he saw James G. Gray sign seal & as his act & deed deliver the same and that
