



Moore corner there thence N^o. 29 W. down a branch as it meanders 21 chain to a stake by a hickory thence S. 60 W. 9 ch. to a hickory on John Cannell's line, thence S. 33 E. 9 25 links to a hickory on John Cannell's line thence S. 36 W. 13 ch. 50 links to a hickory and chestnut on the bank of a branch thence up said branch as it meanders 11 chain, 50 links to a hickory Capt. Moore corner there on an old road to the Beginning, Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Sammon his heirs and assigns, forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Sammon his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that James Blair of Franklin County and State of Georgia for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty two Dollars to me in hand paid by William Morrow of Greenville District and State of South Carolina I have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Morrow all that tract or plantation of Land Containing two hundred and twenty three acres be the same more or less Beginning on a Stake running S. 65 E. 56 95 L. to a black oak thence N 25 E. 36 L. to a stake thence S. 65 S. 21 E. 56 95 L. to a stake thence S. 10 W. 30 L. to a Stake then S. 25 W. 43 L. to a red oak thence N. 51 W. 34 L. to a Stake thence N 25 E. 36 L. to the beginning it being part of a tract of Land.
