To have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Paden his heirs and assigns forever. And I William Arnold Do hereby bind myself my heirs and administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend the above Premises unto the said William Paden his heirs, administrators and assigns against myself and my heirs, and against every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
