Know all men by these presents that I James Pedew of Greenville District in the state aforesaid, in consideration of five hundred Dollars to me paid by Thomas Pedew of the district aforesaid of state aforesaid. Have granted bargained sold & Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas Pedew a tract of Land containing 427 acres it being part of a tract of Land originally granted to David Milling, containing 840 acres situate in Greenville district on the north East side of Reedy River and hath such shape form & marks as appears by a plat thereof to the said Grant Annexed bounding N. on John Alexander E. on McNight & by Robert Pedew W. by Lindsey Baker. Together with all and singular the Rights Members Hereditaments and appurtenancy to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident. To have & To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas Pedew his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Th. Pedew his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this first day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Ten, & in the thirty fifth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
