Reynolds of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of seventy Dollars to me in hand paid by Raphael Johnson of the district and State aforesaid, Have granted bargain sold and release, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Raphael Johnson two certain lots of Land lying and being in the village of Pleasantburg near Greenville Courthouse known and distinguished in the plan or chart of said Village by the numbers thirty nine and forty Eight, Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have & To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Raphael Johnson his heirs, and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors, & administrators, to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Raphael Johnson his heirs and assigns, against myself & my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand and seal this twenty second day of January one thousand Eight hundred and Eleven and in the thirty fifth year of the American Independance, Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of R. H. Briggs
