I know all men by these Presents that I John Slaton of the State of Tennessee Hawkins County for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me paid by Benjamin Harris of the State aforesaid & Greenville District I have granted bargained sold and released, and by these Presents do bargain sell and release unto the said Benjamin Harris a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred "and fifty" acres more or less, Situate on both sides of the middle fork of Saluda river, bounded as follows, beginning at a white oak on Oyle Camp Creek, state line to original line, a conditional line to the river, made by John Slaton Sen. & John Slaton Jr. to a Black gum on the River, thence down the river to the mouth of a Spring branch on a Hickory corner, thence up the Spring branch to a red oak Conditional corner from thence to the old original line, thence along the S. line to Thomas Young's line to a Conditional line made by John Slaton and Thomas Morris, thence across to Oyle Camp Creek to a black Gum, up the said Creek to the beginning - Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments, and appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; To have and to hold all and singular the granted premises before mentioned unto the sa^d Benjamin Harris, his heirs and assigns forever - And I do hereby bind myself my heirs and executors to warrant and defend myself my heirs, or any other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim any part thereof. At Witness my hand and seal this the 18th of December in the year 1807 and in the 29th year of the Independence of America — Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us James Gilliland, Joseph Slaton — John Slaton *L.S.*

State of South Carolina Greenville District - Personally appeared the witness mentioned James Gilliland before me, and made oath that he saw the witness mentioned John Slatton sign seal acknowledge and deliver the witness deed of Conveyance to the witness mentioned Benjamin Harris, after act & seal for all the purposes therein mentioned; and that at the same time he saw Joseph Slaton with him sign their names as subscribing witnesses to the same — Proven the 6th Day of August AD 1808 before me W^m H^r Cooke J. P. [Recorded the 28th December]

156 State of South Carolina Greenville District - I know all men by these Presents that we Edward Slaton Nancy Slaton, Aaron Slaton and Martha Slaton, all of the State aforesaid, have bargained & sold and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto Benjamin Harris Two certain Tracts of Land, situate in the district aforesaid on both sides of Saluda river, and the other on a branch of it river, and hath such form and shape as the above plots represent - Beginning at the Conditional line between said Harris and Slaton, thence down said river to a Stake, thence on land granted to David Morris, thence N. 35 E 31° 6' to a Stake, thence N. 35 E 38 to Stake, thence E. 55 W. to a P. oak thence N. W. to a Dogwood, thence S. 35 W. to a Hickory, thence to a Spanish Oak, thence to a Hickory, thence E. to a White oak thence S. W. to a Stake, thence S. E. to Hickory, thence S. E. to a Post Oak, thence the same direction to a Poplar and Stake, thence N. 35 E. to a Stake on Woods line, thence on Woods line to a cedar Oak, thence to a Hickamore, thence to the original between said Harris and Slaton. to contain three hundred acres (or be the same more or less) Together with all and singular the right, members hereditaments & appurtenances, therunto belonging - and we do warrant and defend the same from ourselves our heirs & assigns, & from every person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part thereof, on Witness our hands & seals this 15th of February 1811 —
