District and State aforesaid, for and in consideration of five hundred dollars to me paid by A.
Barrett of the district and State aforesaid, have granted bargained and sold and released, and by
these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the A. Barrett three parcels of land
containing two hundred and eighty nine acres in the whole, one originally granted to John
Lafferty One hundred acres, and runs as follows, bounded on the S. West by a conditional line, which
runs through said land, on the N. by land that did belong to Wm. Bond, and on the E. by land belonging
to J. Smith, including one hundred acres more or less; The other originally granted to Patrick
Poffey, being & lying in the County aforesaid on the South West side of ready river, as will
more fully appear by the Plat — Also a tract of land Eighty nine acres, Originally granted
to Samuell Wells, being and laying in the district afores^d on a branch of Reedy River as will
more fully appear by the Plat: Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments,
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have &
to hold all and singular the premises, before mentioned unto the said A. Barrett his heirs & assigns
