fore the signing of this presents I have delivered her and whereupon she is now living  
to have & to hold all & singular the above mentioned premises to her the said Ann  
Dowdhet her heirs Executors & administrators from hence forth as her and their  
lawfull right absolutely without any manner of condition. In witness  
Whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 25<sup>th</sup> day March in the year of  
our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirteen signed sealed and delivered

to me in hand paid by William Mayhall of the District aforesaid state aforesaid have granted  
Bargained, sold, and released, & by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto  
the said W<sup>m</sup> Mayhall one hundred & fifty acres of land more or less lying in Greenville  
District on the waters of reedy river it being a part of a tract of land originally Grant  
ed to John Lafferty and is laid out unto the said Mayhall as follows Beginning at  
the State corner of David Armstrong land thence running along s<sup>e</sup> armstrongs line to
