


South Carolina Greenville District Personally came Sarah Underwood before me

The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Charly Williamson
of State of North Carolina & County of Buncombe for and in consideration of the sum
of one hundred dollars to me paid by Gabriel Benson of the State of South
Carolina and district of Greenville, Have granted bargained sold and released
and by these presents do grant bargain sold and released unto the said Gabriel
Benson his heirs and assigns all that piece or parcel of land lying on both side
of the south fork of Mathews creek in the district of Greenville, Beginning on a
sprue pine on Mathews creek just below the mouth of the south fork of said
creek and running with John Tarwaters line to his corner thence by the meander
of the ridge dividing the waters of the two creeks aforesaid to Master old corner
thence along Gabriel Benson's line to Richard Holomony corner thence by the
meander of the ridge along said Holomony line as marked to the Beginning
being part of a tract of land originally granted to Thomas Macta, the part
now conveyed containing one hundred and sixty acre more or less, both ad
boundy on said Tarwaters land Richard Williamson's land said Gabriel Benson
land, and Richard Holomans land, Together with all and singular the right
members hereditament and appurtenance to the said premises belonging or in
any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the
premises before mentioned unto the said Gabriel Benson his heirs and assigns
forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators
to warrant and esch defend all and singular the premises aforesaid unto
the said Gabriel Benson his heirs and assigns against myself my Executors &
administrators and against the claim of any person or persons whomsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof; Witness my hand
and seal this 20th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and thirteen and thirty seventh year of the independence of the
