The State of South Carolina. This Indenture made this 29th day of October in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and thirteen between Henry Middleton of the City of Charleston and
State aforesaid of the one part, and Elias Earle of Pendleton District in the said State of the other
part. Witnesseth that the said Henry Middleton by his three several bonds or obliga-
tions bearing even date with these presents stands bound unto the said Elias Earle in the
sum of five thousand four hundred & Sixty Dollars payable at three several instalments
with conditions hereunder written for the payment of Nine hundred and ten Dollars
at each of the said instalments, of one two and three years, with lawful interest from the date to
be paid at the several periods in the conditions of the said Bonds mentioned, as by reference
to the same will more fully appear. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said
Henry Middleton for and in Consideration of the said debt of sum of Five Thou-
sand four hundred and Sixty Dollars, and for the better securing the payment of the
said sum of Twenty seven hundred and Thirty Dollars, with Interest unto the said
Elias Earle his certain attorney his heirs executors administrators or assigns according to
the conditions of the said several Bonds or obligations aforesaid are also in consideration
of the further sum of ten acres to him the said Henry Middleton, in hand paid by the said
Elias Earle at & before the sealing and Delivering of these presents. The receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged. Hetherto granted bargained sold and released and by these
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Elias Earle all those several plan-
tations or tracts of land situated lying and being in the District of Greenville and
State aforesaid on the Branches of Richlands Creek, waters of Reedy River, contain-
ning in the whole Seven hundred and thirteen acres (now or left) being the whole of
two surveys originally granted to James Ritchey of 200 and 9.45 acres. Except 6 acres sold David
Goodlett also a tract of 19 acres Granted to Colcock, 149 acres part of a tract originally
Granted to John Timmons, and 6 acres part of a tract originally Granted to David Goodlett
as by reference to the said original papers may more fully appear, Records. Together with all
and singular the right members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular
the said premises unto the said Elias Earle his heirs and assigns forever. Provided
always. Nevertheless and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents
that if the said Henry his heirs Executors or administrators do will and truly pay or cause
to be paid to the said Elias Earle his certain attorney, heirs Executors administrators or assign-
ees the said sum of Twenty seven hundred and Thirty Dollars with Interest as aforesaid, ac-
cording to the true intent and meaning of the said Bonds or Obligations aforesaid, and the
conditions there under written. Then, and in that case this present Indenture and every
clause & article containing ^{herein} shall be null and void anything therein to the contrary pur-
in any wise notwithstanding. and it is agreed upon between the parties to these presents
