Know all men by these presents that Miles Jennings of Greenville District and State aforesaid in consideration of Fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by Samuel Williams of the State and District aforesaid, here granted bargain and sold & by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel Williams all that plantation or tract of Land lying in State & District aforesaid on Mountain Creek waters of Saluda River, Being part of a tract originally granted to Miles Jennings by his Excellency Wth Moultrie the 3rd day of April 1786 and said to be conveyed by said Jennings to Geo. Pearce & by Pearce to John Watkins and Deed to Land Green then conveyed to Ambrose Hammons, Beginning on a silver gum on Roberts line thence a south course about 48.50 to a stake on French's line thence on French's line 20 ch 50 links to a red oak 3 x three & W. 21 chain to a pine 3 x thence on conditional line made by John Layman & Alex Pennington to a black oak corner 13 x, then to a W. oak on Laymans spring branch then down s^o branch to Morris's hickory corner, thence to the beginning, containing fifty acres more or less, Together with all & singular the rites members Hereditaments and appertinances to the premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the s^o Samuel Williams his heirs Exors &c against myself & my heirs & I do hereby bind myself & my heirs to warrant & forever defend the above described Land to Samuel Williams his heirs assigns &c against myself my heirs. In witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my Seal this 22nd day January in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred Thirteen and in Thirty seventh year of the American Independence . . .
