these presents that I William D. Thomas of Greenville District and
State of South Carolina for & in consideration of Nine Hundred and
fifty ^{Dollars} to me in hand paid by Thomas Edwards of the District and State
aforesaid have granted bargained & sold and by these presents do grant
bargain & sell into the said Thomas Edwards a tract or parcel of
land I purchased from my Father John Thomas where he formerly lived
on, & deceased containing Three Hundred acres be the same more or less, which
land was originally granted to Major Parsons & from him conveyed to
Thomas Todd & from him conveyed to John Thomas & then to the said
William D. Thomas it being and lying in Greenville District & State aforesaid
on South Tiger River Beginning on S^o side of said River on the
lower line of said tract formerly granted to Major Parsons, of six hundred
and forty acres it being part of said Tract - Crossing the river Northwesterly
along said line to a post oak corner thence westerly to a post oak corner, then
southerly to Robert Carters line, thence down the river along said Carters
line to a gum corner thence along the meanders of said River to the begin-
ning, containing Three Hundred acres more or less, together with all & singular
the Rights members Hereditaments & appurtenances thereto belonging
or in any wise incident or appertaining unto the said Thomas Edwards &
his heirs forever. & I do bind myself my heirs Executors &c to warrant and
forever defend all & singular the above described premises unto the said Thos.
Edwards his heirs Executors &c from me & my heirs & from every other person
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part or parcel thereof
Given under my hand & seal this ninth day of February 1814. Signed seal

¶ Be it remembered that by mutual agreement between the said
William D. Thomas and Thomas Edwards that they do agree to swap a small
corner Belonging to each party so that the corners of the lower line between
them begin at the mouth of a branch below the bridge at the river and
then running up the meanders of said branch to the original line and each
of them do bind themselves their heirs &c in the sum of five hundred
dollars to stand to and abide by said swap and do warrant and defend from
themselves theirs &c the land mentioned as a swap
