same district and state aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
to be satisfied and paid and for the said sum hath granted bargained & sold and
by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said Isaac Towers to him
his heirs Executors adm^r or assigns one Hundred acres of Land situate lying
on the branches of Sealders Creek the waters of Enore River, beginning on a
stake on Peake's line, running S. 70. W. 13 Chain 50 links to a stake then S
7 Chain 25 links to a stake then N. 78 W 13 Chain 30 links to a red oak, then S 5 E
19 Chain 50 links to a maple by a branch, then up a small fork of said branch
11 Chain to a red oak, then N 2. W. 25 Chains to pine then N 77. W. 12 Chains 75
links to black Jack then N. 17 Chain to pine stump then S. 76. E 40 chains to the
beginning, to include all in said bounds for one Hundred acres of Land let there
be more or less. Together with all the premises and appurtenances therunto
belonging to the only proper use & behoof of him the said Isaac Towers him
