of a tract of Land originally granted unto said Boley Conner for 556 acres
to the same more or less beginning on a post oak running N. 66. E. 47. to a stake
thence N. 21. E. 4. 6. to a stake thence S. 85. W. 56. 6. 50L to a post oak thence
S. 22. E. 25. 6. 20L to the beginning post oak corner, by estimation Eighty three
acres & more or less together with all and singular the Rights and members
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise ~~incident~~
appertaining to have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said Thomas Chapman his heirs & assigns for ever, and I do hereby
bind myself and my heirs and assigns to warrant and for ever defend all and
the above mentioned premises against all persons whomsoever laying any just
claim or claims unto the same or any part thereof and will warrant and
defend the same from my heirs and every other person whatsoever (originally
Granted to said Boley Conner on the fifth day of March 1804 and recorded
