sum of one Hundred & fifty Dollars paid by Robert Ferguson of District and  
State aforesaid have Granted Bargained sold & released and by these pre-  
sents do Grant Bargain sell & Release unto the said Robert Ferguson part  
of that tract or parcel of Land that was conveyed from Abraham Thomas  
McCool to Charles Crane containing one Hundred and fifty acres (be the  
same more or less) being the part that the said now lies on Beginning on a white  
oak running thence to a black oak corner on Thomas Walling line, thence  
said Walling crossing Beaverland creek to a post oak corner thence on  
said Walling line to a pine corner thence on said Walling to a black  
oak corner thence to the dividing line between Charles Crane and Wm  
Crane thence down the meanders of the branch to McCools creek  
thence up said creek to a black gum station thence to a poste oak corner  
thence to a poplar corner thence to the beginning. Together with all and  
singular the rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said  
tract belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold  
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Robert Ferguson  
his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all & singular  
the said premises unto the said Robert Ferguson in heirs & assigns against
