In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal affixed my seal the fifteenth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fourteen.

This Indenture made this 31st day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen, between Jonathan Blythe of the State of South Carolina and County of Pendleton of the one part and Adam Smith of the State of South Carolina and district of Greenville of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Jonathan Blythe for his consideration of fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Adam Smith, hath bargained and sold, and by these Presents doth bargain sell and make over and confirm unto the said Adam Smith his heirs, & assigns, a certain tract of land containing sixty acres, more or less, according to the Plat and Grant, granted to Robt Bean the said land situate in the State of South Carolina and district of Greenville beginning at the mouth of Stewarts Creek, thence up the said creek, it being the line of said grant, thence \$66 W to a Pine Corner thence \$24 E to a box oak on the river, thence down the river to the beginning, and both such shapes as appear by a Plat and Grant, cutficed for the said Robt Bean: To have and to hold the said land and premises to him his heirs and assigns, against the said Jonathan Blythe for himself his heirs and assigns well warrant and forever defend the title of the said land from any person or persons laying any just
