The State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I William Arnold of the
district of Laurens in the State aforesaid in consideration of seven hundred dollars to me
paid by William Thomason of Greenville district in the State aforesaid have granted
bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
unto the said William Thomason all that plantation tract of land containing two hun-
dred and seventy acres (but the same more less) situate in Greenville district
lying on Reedy River Beginning on a Line 3+ on said river thence S 76 W. 56 to a
red oak 3+ bounding on Wm. Dunklin's land thence S 14 W. 14.50 to a Stake 3+ thence
S 75 W. 13.50 to a hickory 3+ thence S 30 E. 7 to a Stake 3+, the last mentioned line is
bounding on Thomas Hamilton's thence S 60 W. 1.30 to a Hickory 3+, thence S 20 E. 13.
50 to a red oak 3+ near the head of a branch, bounding on the heirs of John Thomas
deceased thence down the meander of said branch about 64.50 to an ash 3+ thence
N 14 E 27 to a Beach 3+ on said river, thence up the meander of the beginning
Tog. thence with all and singular the rights members heretofore appurte-
nances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
said William Thomason his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby
bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant & forever
defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Wm. Thomason his
heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other
person whom ever lawfully coming onto claim the same or any part
thereof. Wtchop my hand and seal this ninth day of May in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen and in the thirty
seventh of the Independence of the United States of America. —
