

ted in five years after the first Settlement made by Geo. French in 1791  
with all and singular the rights, members & appurtenances to said land belonging  
in eident or in any way well appurtening, and the right Title claim or interest  
the said George French had in the said land at the time of sol. To have and to  
hold the said land as above described unto the said John French his heirs  
and assigns forever (subject as above mentioned) In Witness whereof I

for and in Consideration of one hundred dollars to me paid by  
by David Thomas of the aforesaid State and District, have bargained  
and sold, and by these presents do give, grant, release, and make  
over unto the said David Thomas, a certain tract of land, Situate  
lying, and being in the aforesaid State and District, on the waters  
of Saluda River, containing thirty five acres more or less, it being  
part of a tract of land granted to Robert Gilland: (The course  
distance, and boundary of the lines of the said part or tract  
of land, are as follows (viz) Beginning on a Stake 111x thence N. 50 W.  
15 Ch. to a Stake, bounded by land belonging to Isaac West, thence  
S. 50 W. 35 Ch. to a pine 111x bounded by land belonging to the said  
David Thomas, thence S. 75 E. 23 Ch. 25 l. to a Stake 111x bounded by  
land belonging to Braxsdales D. Garrison, thence N. 33 E. 15 Ch. to the  
beginning 111x bounded by land belonging to myself) together
