
This Indenture made this seventh day of December in the year of our Lord 356  
one thousand and seven hundred and ninety eight, between Harris Mullins of the  
State of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part, and John Loveliss  
of the State and County aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in con-  
sideration of the sum of one hundred dollars in hand paid by the s<sup>r</sup> John Loveliss  
the receipt whereof he the said Harris Mullins doth hereby acknowledge, he hath  
bargained and sold by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said John  
Loveliss his heirs and assigns forever, all that plantation or tract of land  
containing fifty acres, more or less, situate lying and being in Greenville  
County on the north side of Little Horse Creek, bounded on the S. side Henry  
Barrow line, on the West side Jacob Nabors line, on the N. by Hages line, on the  
East by Harris Mullins line, being part of a tract of land granted to Wm. Story  
and conveyed to Sam<sup>r</sup> Chastain, and also conveyed from s<sup>r</sup> Chastain to s<sup>r</sup>  
Mullins, reference being thereto had may more fully appear, and also all  
the land, trees, timber trees, woods under woods by this common of pasture  
ways water water courses and appurtenances what, soever to the same belonging  
or in any wise appertaining, and also the reversion and reversion, remainder &  
remainder rights free and service, of the said premises, and every part &  
parcel thereof; and all the estate rights and titles, interests, claims & demands,  
whatsoever of him the s<sup>r</sup> Harris Mullins of in and to the said premises, every  
part thereof; To have and to hold the said tract of fifty acres of land, more  
or less, and all and singular the premises, above mentioned and every  
part thereof with the appurtenances unto the said John Loveliss his heirs  
and assigns forever. And the said Harris Mullins for himself and his heirs  
the said tract of land and premises, and every part thereof, against him &  
his heirs, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever will  
warrant and forever defend to the said John Loveliss his heirs & assigns forever  
by these presents. In witness whereof the said Harris Mullins hath hereunto  
set his hand and affixed his seal, the day and year first above written.
