1st. Samuel Earle & Harriet his wife have received, in addition to property heretofore
received by them, one negro fellow named Abram, one negro Wench named Nancy
and her young child Travis, one girl named Eliza, one negro Boy named Abram and
one girl named Flora, and shall stand charged as having received of the said Estate
from the first to the present time the sum of three thousand one hundred & fifty dollars.

2^d. John H. Garrison in addition to the property heretofore received by him shall take one
Negro fellow named Prince, one negro girl named Phoebe and an old fellow named
Jupiter, and stand charged as having received from the first to the present time
the sum of two thousand seven hundred dollars nineteen cents -

3rd. Jane Wright in addition to the property received at her marriage, has received all the
readymoney on hand at the time of the death of the said James Harrison, one negro fellow
named Mark, one negro wench named Jude, and her small child, one girl named Abby,
one boy named Bob, one other boy named Harry, and one boy named Allen. and shall
stand charged as having received of the said "estate" from the first to the present time
the sum of two thousand eight hundred and forty dollars, over and above all the ready
money above mentioned, which last is a specific legacy, and is hereby acknowledged
to be fully paid - 4th. James Harrison in addition to his old account, has received
six Negroes, Edy & her children, Belle, Patience, Sury, Johnson and Norman, and also
a Crippled boy named Willis, and shall be charged as having received from the first
to the present time, the sum of two thousand eight hundred and eighty one dollars forty six cents.

5th. Richard Harrison has in addition to his old account received, one boy named Morris
and one girl named Lydia, and shall be charged with the sum of two thousand
seven hundred and eighty two dollars forty eight cents, from the first to the present time.

6th. Isham Garrison shall have one negro fellow Tobe, and one boy, Simon, in addition
and shall be charged from the first to the present time, the sum of two thousand five
hundred and seventy nine dollars. - 7th. Thomas Garrison in addition to property
heretofore received, shall have one Wench named Binder and her three Children
George, Flanders and Dolly, and one old Wench named Dolly, and shall be charged as
having received the sum of two thousand eight hundred and fifty dollars from the first to the
present time. - 8th. Rowland Thurn and Elizabeth his wife have received five
hundred and eighty five dollars in cash, in addition to the property before received by
them, and shall be charged with the sum of two thousand eight hundred and thirty five
dollars, from first to the present time. - 9th. Asa Early Harris and Polly L. his wife
shall receive in addition one Family of Negroes, Isaac, Patience & Cornelia, one
Waggon and gear, and one Horse, and shall charged with the sum of three thousand
one hundred and five dollars, from the first to the present time.
