

Crittenden one lot or parcel of land containing half an acre, more or less, situate
lying and being in the village at Greenville Courthouse known and distinguished
in the Plan or Chart of said Village by number four (4) Beginning on a
Stake corner running thence N 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 152 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a Stake, thence S 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 100
feet to a Stake, thence S 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 152 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a Stake, thence N 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 100
feet to the beginning. Together with all & singular, the rights, members, hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertain-
ing. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said John
Crittenden his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my
heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all & singular
the said premises unto the said John Crittenden his heirs & assigns against myself
& my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or
