paid by Samuel Williams of Greenville County & State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold & released  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Samuel Williams all that  
Plantation or tract of land, this twentieth day of January eighteen hundred & fifteen, Situate  
in the district of Ninety Six, in Greenville County and Granted to Daniel Faust on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of  
November 1791 Containing five hundred and fifty acres, Situate on the water of Saluda & on  
both sides of Clark's Trail, bounding S.E. on Edwin Smith's land, W. on John Waldeop's land N.W.  
on Robert Maxwell's land, E. & N.E. on Survey's unknown S.E. on George Pearce's land, & hath such  
fence & mark as the annexed plat represents. Together with all and singular the rights  
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident  
or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Samuel  
Williams his heirs & assigns forever. And I the said William Hart do hereby bind myself my heirs  
Executor & Administrator, to warrant & forever defend all & singular the premises unto the said  
Samuel Williams his heirs & assigns against myself & Heirs, & all & every other person or persons  
whatever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, from or under me.  
Witness my hand & seal this twentieth day of January eighteen hundred & fifteen, & thirty
