 Beginning on a Post Oak corner, thence running S<sup>26</sup>W. 55 ch<sup>s</sup> 430 links to Pine corner, thence  
 running N<sup>19</sup>W. 23 ch<sup>s</sup> to a Black Oak "corner", thence running S<sup>76</sup>W. 17 ch<sup>s</sup> to a Pine stump  
 corner, thence running N. 34 W. 41 chains 80 link, to a Stake corner, thence running S<sup>60</sup>E. 41/2 chain,  
 50 link, to a Stake corner, thence running N. 26 E. 99 ch<sup>s</sup> 75 link, to Pine corner, thence running  
 N. 60 E. 43 chain, to Stake corner, thence running S<sup>62</sup>E. 51 ch<sup>s</sup> 50 link, to a Post oak corner, thence  
 running N. 61 E. 17 chain, 15 links, to a black oak, thence running S<sup>23</sup>W. 16 ch<sup>s</sup> to a hickory  
 corner, thence running S<sup>40</sup>W. 41 chain, to a Post oak corner, thence running N. 60 W. 44 ch<sup>s</sup> 50 link,

 said Silas Holloway all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the district  
 & State aforesaid, on the waters of Saluda river, or rather, the Golden Grove creek -  
 Beginning at a Stake on Jeremiah Cleveland's line, thence S<sup>45</sup>W. 35 chains, on said  
 Holloway's line to Jones' corner on a Black Oak, thence N. 48 W. 43 chains, along Jones'  
 line to a Black Oak, thence N. 45 E. 40 chains, on the Widow Somerlin or Sawley line
